 Plot is defined as the organized pattern or sequence of events that make up a story. Every plot is made up of a series of incidents that are related to each other.








1. This usually occurs at the beginning of a story. Here the characters are introduced. We also learn about the setting. Most importantly, we are introduced to the main conflict, the problem.




2. This part of the story starts to develop the conflict(s). A building of interest or suspense starts to occur.








3. This is the turning point of the story. Usually the main character comes face to face with a conflict. The main character will change in some way.








4. All the loose ends of the plot are tied up. The conflict and climax are taken care of.







5. The story comes to a reasonable ending.

- 3. Climax


