
HOW TO SUBMIT... IC: SUMMARIZE PODCAST

ENG1ACR has several different types of assignments (some are trickier than others); most of your assignments should be submitted as a **document**, so that's a good place for us to start. These are step-by-step instructions:


Let's say you want to submit the podcast summary in the Internet Communications unit. First, listen to the podcast and, while you are listening, write down a few notes about what the speaker is telling you. Keep in mind that it is a **50-point assignment** so you will want to include several pieces of information in your summary to show that you understood the speaker's message. When you are ready to write your summary:

- 1. Open up a new Word, Works, or OpenOffice document.
- 2. Type the information you want to turn in (be sure to include your name).
- 3. Run spell-check and grammar-check to catch any errors that might cost you points.
- 4. Save it to your computer. You will want to click on "Save as", give the document a name, such as "Internet Podcast Summary", and change the file type to "Rich Text Format." I know that you might be working at a different school computer every day, so you will want to submit your assignments just as soon as you finish them. Don't wait! Another student could use the same computer and copy your work.

In the **Internet Communications** section of our course you see the link to **IC-Internet Communication Project: Summarize Podcast;** when you click on that link you see this:



If you click on the first link (**Summarize Podcast**) you find the instructions for the assignment. If you click on the second link (**submit your assignment here**) it opens to the dropbox where you will attach the document you have saved to your computer. Here is a screen shot of that link:



Do not type anything in the Comments box; right underneath the box you see "attach local file"; click on the *browse* button and find the assignment you have just saved to your computer; when you find the file and click on it, it will automatically upload to this dropbox; then you just click "submit" and you're done!
