



## Main idea is found in non-fiction








Theme is the lesson or observation about life that you find in fiction, drama, and poetry

# Main idea is what the author is saying about the subject







•Main Idea may be stated in the thesis of the passage

•The thesis may be found at the beginning or end of a work

Paraphrasing difficult sections or restating them in your own words can also be helpful



#### - Dictionary

dic-tion-ar-y |'dik sh ə,nere | (abbr.: dict.)

noun (pl. -ar-ies)

- a book that lists the words of a language in alphabetical order and gives their meaning, or that gives the equivalent words in a different language.
  - a reference book on any subject, the items of which are arranged in alphabetical order: a dictionary of quotations.

#### PHRASES

have swallowed a dictionary informal (of a person) use long and obscure words when speaking.

ORIGIN early 16th cent.: from medieval Latin *dictionarium (manuale)* or *dictionarius (liber) 'manual or book of words*,' from Latin *dictio* (see DICTION ).
