THE PERSONAL ESSAY: PORTFOLIO

- 1. Create a folder; name it "Personal Essay Unit."
- 2. Choose ONE of the prompts on the first page of the 9 page packet. Brainstorm about that prompt. Write whatever comes into your head. There's no right or wrong, it's a random flow of ideas and thoughts. Save your brainstorming as "Prewriting 1A" in the Personal Essay Unit folder.
- 3. If you like the prompt, keep it and write more about it. If, after brainstorming, you don't like it, switch to another prompt. BUT if you switch, you have to brainstorm for that one, too! Save that new brainstorm in your folder:-)
- 4. After you've brainstormed, you're going to begin outlining for your 5-paragraph essay. You can do this a number of different ways; pick which one you like best. See page 3 for outlining examples. Save it as Prewriting 2 in your folder.
- 5. When you're done outlining your personal 5-paragraph essay, you're going to pick another person's essay to read. Your four choices are on page 6. Take notes on the essay of your choice; the notes should be about the author's style of writing and his purpose. Was he trying to entertain the audience? Persuade the audience? etc. SAVE this as Reading 1 and put it in your folder.
- 6. Now it's your turn: write the 3 body paragraphs to YOUR essay. Put each paragraph on a separate page and save it as Writing 1 (put in folder!)
- 7. After reading the example of different kinds of writing (expository, narrative, etc.), you'll write your introductory and conclusion paragraphs. One paragraph per page and don't forget to save it as Writing 2!
- 8. It's revision time. Copy all of your paragraphs from Writing 1 and Writing 2 into one document. For the first time you're looking at all 5 paragraphs together. Revise. Save work as Revision 1.
- 9. Once you've revised all 5 paragraphs as a whole, have someone else read it or print it out and read it aloud, etc. Once it's perfect, you're ready to save it as Final. Be sure to meet the essay requirements on page 8!

HELPFUL HINT: before you submit the portfolio (that's the ENTIRE folder titled Personal Essay Unit), grade it yourself using the rubric on page 9. If you have everything, submit it through the course! YOU'RE DONE:-)
